

## **winDMX48 (German) Installation Instructions**

- Using the Start>Run button (or Windows Explorer) open the Setup.exe file on the CD-ROM.
- A number of support files will be installed on your computer. After it is finished, the Install program may require you to re-boot your machine before you can continue.
- The next screen says “Starten Sie die Installation...” It is asking you where you want the Program to be installed. The default directory is C:\Program Files\winDMX48. I suggest that you use that directory, but if you want to change it, click on the “Verzeichnis wechseln” button. Click on the large button showing a computer to continue the installation. Clicking on “Setup beenden” exits without doing the setup.
- Next, you will be given a chance to choose a Program Group. I suggest using the default choice, “KWL-Lighting.” Click on the “Weiter” button.
- A bar graph display will show the progress of the installation. Allow it to continue. When done, it will close itself.
- A final screen will appear to indicate that the installation is complete. Click on “OK.”

### **Notes**

- The WinDMX program should now be present in your Start>Programs directory. You can start it here; or you can create a shortcut on your Desktop in the normal fashion. The program you are looking for is “winDMX.exe”
- There are a number of sample demonstration files provided for you to experiment with; all of the “shows” created by WinDMX have a “KWL” extension (the three letters in the file name after the period).
- To connect a DXG-48 (also provided by **brightline**) you will need a Null Modem serial cable. A regular serial (straight through) cable will not work.
- You will need to set your screen resolution to a minimum of 1024x768 in order to use winDMX properly. The number of colors should also be set to at least “High Color 16 bit.”
